



Dental coverage after TRICARE Retiree Dental Program:

The facts you need to know.

TRDP coverage ends December 31, 2018.

This affects all retired service members and family members eligible for TRDP. If you are now enrolled in a TRDP plan, you will not be automatically enrolled in a federal dental plan for 2019.

FACT: You have options.

- You'll have the chance to compare benefits and rates from different carriers.
- Spouses, dependents and survivors are eligible, even if the retiree does not enroll.
- Dependents are eligible until age 21, with full-time students eligible until age 23.

FACT: GEHA offers you more.

- GEHA is one of six nationwide FEDVIP carriers you can choose from during Open Season for coverage beginning January 1, 2019.
- All GEHA dental plans include additional benefits of vision and hearing aid coverage, as well as preferred pricing on medical alert services and teeth whitening.
- Our nationwide network has more than 340,000 provider locations.
- Plans have no waiting period for root canals, crowns, bridges, dentures, periodontal surgery and implants.
- Children qualify for free tooth sealants and fluoride treatments, when they see an in-network provider.

FACT: You must take action.

- To avoid a gap in coverage, sign up for a new plan during Federal Benefits Open Season, November 12, 2018, through midnight EST December 10, 2018.

- † Class A, B, and C Covered Services are limited to a combined Calendar Year Maximum Benefit of \$35,000 for High Option and \$2,500 for Standard Option, per covered person.
- †† Limited to a lifetime maximum of \$3,500 under High Option and \$2,500 Standard Option, per covered person.

As with all FEDVIP plans, dental benefits available from your FEHB carrier will be considered before we calculate benefits paid by GEHA.
